Jeff earned his bachelor's degree in civil engineering and went on to pursue a master's degree in environmental engineering from UNH. While a graduate student at UNH, Jeff took time to go back to Pinkerton as a guest speaker, passing on what he had learned, with the hope that he might help to foster another student's passion for science.

Jeff was also an avid outdoors man. He would frequently be found skiing, hiking, biking, and camping. Jeff found his niche in sharing his love of the outdoors with others. While he worked and while he played you could always count on learning something from Jeff's experience.
